



DISTRICT PRIORITIES TASKFORCE MINUTES

The West Orange Healthcare District Priorities Taskforce met Monday, May 10, 2021 at the Healthy West Orange Building. Chairman, R. Talbot officially called the meeting to order at 7:35 AM after a quorum was established. **Trustees in Attendance:** N. Sutton, L. Cervenka, M. Lee, R. Talbot; W. Britt, T. Keating, **Remote:** K. R. Talbot noted that since there were no members of the public in attendance, there would be no public comment period.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Board Action: Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the May 3, 2021 meeting of the District Priorities Taskforce were unanimously approved.

SENIOR CARE: DEVELOPMENT OF FOCUS AND NEXT STEPS

T. Swanson began discussion of the work to date, reminding the Task Force of insights shared by the Subject Matter Expert guests at the previous meeting, gaps in senior services that had been identified, and potential opportunities, audiences, and partnerships.

Members continued the discussion of which areas the District could have the most impact and how strategy/plans should be prioritized based on conversations to date. The Task Force identified their desire for a Senior or Creative Aging Center that could accommodate robust programming and even include services like adult daycare, potentially incorporating recreation and educational opportunities for school-aged children to accommodate a multi-generational approach to programming and community engagement.

The Task Force requested next steps for the staff to include the exploration of partnerships and opportunities that could help build or guide the vision, including reaching back out to subject matter experts.
